



The “Neonatal Haemodynamics & Targeted Neonatal Echocardiography” training program in Vancouver is operated in two streams, in collaboration with the Division of Cardiology. The training positions are open to candidates who have completed 2-years of neonatal fellowship in Canada, or equivalent, on a competitive basis.

Stream 1: Those with experience in operation in echocardiography

- One-year under the supervision of Neonatology: include training of Neonatology, plus advanced training of Targeted Neonatal Echocardiography (i.e. develop echocardiographic interpretation and diagnostic skills as it applies to the neonatal patient population).

Stream 2: Those with no experience in operation in echocardiography - the training program includes two parts:

- Year 1 under the supervision of Cardiology: includes in-depth training of paediatric cardiology, including echocardiography.
- Year 2 under the supervision of Neonatology: include training of Neonatology, plus advanced training of Targeted Neonatal Echocardiography (i.e. develop echocardiographic interpretation and diagnostic skills as it applies to the neonatal patient population).
